Sunflower, yarrow, dogwood, lily of the valley and penstemon float up from the dark background giving the colors an extra pop. This one would be universally likable.

This second image from Susan includes the logo for Shiloh Hills and has a more playful approach. She mixed some realistic florals with childlike images that she believes gives a family friendly vibe. Bright poppies, toadflax, and phlox dance between basic shapes of tulip and daisy for a coloring book feel that kids will love.
