Ms Amber Groe of Office of Neighborhood Services (ONS) will give an update what is going on in our City.

Community Health Association of Spokane (CHAS) will talk about the clinics at Rogers High and Shiloh Hills Elementary schools. These clinics serve our students who attend District 81 (Spokane) and District 354 (Mead) schools. CHAS Health offers primary care, pediatrics, women's health, specialty care, behavioral health services, and urgent care at locations throughout Spokane County. CHAS is a federally qualified health center (FQHC) serving everyone by offering health services to all ages and income levels.

Shiloh Hills Neighborhood Council has not had any new members of our executive team for quite some time. We need volunteers to take up the work that keeps our neighborhood council running. We hope that folks can spend a couple of hours each month to keep this neighborhood council running.

A possible solution would for our neighborhood council to only meet quarterly if we do not get new volunteers on our executive team.
