## Parks

Lighting  
Amenities: bathrooms, Kiosks

Shelters, resources for evictions or unhoused

## Land Use

Walkability – bikes  
Schools  
Urban forestry- trees, Spokane scape, heat islands, climate resiliency  
Green way to Children of the Sun  
Transit Oriented Design (TOD), Multi/mixed use zoning, Density near Division, trees on arterials

## Transportation/Connectivity

Overgrown sidewalks/Snow removal issues  
Nevada, Division, Newport Hwy speed and safety: safe road designs  
Drag racing issue  
Major Intersections signage – lighting  
Safe bicycle, walking connectivity to neighborhood shopping  
Bus shelters & info on STA routes

## Sense of Security

Derelict cars/RVs  
Street lights: walking in dark  
Pets off leash  
Children walking in neighborhood & to school

## Neighbor's comments from our October 17 meeting:

- We need a defined sense of community/location
- We need ongoing police patrols for trouble neighborhoods
- We need speed bumps to control car speed
- Land should be set aside to create designated gathering places
- Everyone should feel safe and welcome in our community
- Protected bike lanes that have a barrier would increase safety for pedestrians and bicycles
