Spokane Police Dept. Report: SPD is launching a new Gun Crime Unit to reduce gun related crimes citywide 10% by the end of 2026. The strategic plan focuses on prevention, faster investigation, and stronger collaboration with community groups. The team will be based out of the Northeast Precinct and includes a sergeant, three patrol officers, and three detectives working 4:00 p.m. to 2:30 a.m.

ONS Report: Free solar powered security lights are still available to be picked up by city residents at city hall.
